NATES MINESHAFT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced four then three wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was well rated while setting the pace, drew off under hand urging in upper stretch then was eased up in the final sixteenth. INFRATTINI settled on the inside, came off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, advanced through along the rail in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly while second best. PROSPECT KNIGHT was a bit eager while rated on the inside, came under some urging on the far turn and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. GENTLE TAP settled at the back of the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to rally. MAXIMUS RULER bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced five then four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn and tired. STRONG APPEAL was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. PREMIER CRU raced three wide on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, was rated on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty.
