INFRATTINI went two then three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, chased on the outside under an all out drive, drew alongside MARK VALESKI outside the sixteenth-pole, brushed with that rival at that point and proved best under good handling. MARK VALESKI became restless after standing in the gate for awhile, was allowed off the inside by INFRATTINI early on the first turn, tracked the pacesetter on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, shook off HURRICANE IKE in upper stretch, brushed with INFRATTINI while being challenged near the sixteenth-pole and was overtaken. HURRICANE IKE set the clear pace, was challenged on the far turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished while just able to get the show. SELF CONTROL went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, moved closer late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch, chased on the outside and finished willingly but lacked a winning kick. BRETHREN went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MACHO BULL settled on the inside, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. WASH PARK went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. RAISON D'ETAT hesitated at the start, settled at the back while on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and showed little.
