TOUCH MAGIC came out and bumped with FLASHY CAMPAIGN entering the first turn, was rated off the pace, came under urging on the far turn, rallied one off the inside in upper stretch, closed determinedly to get the lead just inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong handling. GAL ABOUT TOWN went five then four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a five wide bid at the quarter-pole, edged clear outside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. SMITTEN was slow into stride, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and finished willingly to just get the show. IRISH LUTE stumbled at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and also finished willingly but missed the show. FINDING MORE brushed with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, followed the leader from second, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost touch with GAL ABOUT TOWN approaching the furlong marker and weakened. FLASHY CAMPAIGN was bumped by TOUCH MAGIC entering the first turn then taken up and swerved five wide, dropped to three wide midway through the first bend, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. ESTONIA settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. BROTHERHOOD SINGER went four then three wide

on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. CIAO BELLA LUNA settled near the middle of the field, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came off the rail near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. AFRODITA was hustled from the start, set the clear pace, was challenged on the far turn, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and gave way.
