RY'S THE MAN settled off the pace, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid at the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. CAMPEON bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed. GOLD APPOINTMENT bumped hard with a rival at the start while also bumping with another, dropped in then moved up at the half-mile pole, made a bid passing the seven-sixteenths, vied along the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened while just able to get the show. HIJO DEL CORREDOR was reserved on the outside, dropped in late on the backstretch, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, came back off the rail nearing the quarter-pole and finished willingly to just miss the show. MOON SONG was coaxed along while just off the pace, went three wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick. ONE MORE NIGHT was hustled from the start, settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to rally. REBEL SOUL broke about two lengths slow, moved in at the rear, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ZIP TRIP set the pace under pressure, lost the lead on the turn, chased into the stretch and gave way. FIREBALL MERLIN bumped hard with an opponent at the start, settled near the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch and failed to respond. BATTERED chased the pace, floated off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside and tired. HOT HOT HEAT was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn and came up empty. (Rail at 15 Feet)
