CLOSE ALLY brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, was put to the whip near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied in the final furlong, moved out while gaining near the sixteenth-pole and closed fast to get up late. AMMAROO was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and closed well to get the place. COTILE LAKE was hustled from the start then chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, battled determinedly through a prolonged drive and finished willingly to get the show. YANKEE GONE SOUTH showed good speed from the outside post, sprinted clear after a furlong, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker, remained clear into the final furlong but shortened stride and was caught. BLESSED DAY was ridden along in fourth position, raced two then three wide on the turn, gained some ground in the stretch but lacked the needed kick. SAUCY STASH chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and weakened. DIXIE'S CAT CAN DO was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. FUTURE EMPIRE brushed with a rival at the start then was slow into stride, dropped well behind the field, raced off the rail on the turn and never reached contention. SGT. MAURO dropped back while ridden along, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and was no factor. LITTLE WHISKEY was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. ROYAL VALID was ridden along towards the rear, raced four wide on the turn and also was no factor.
