PRINCE KADEN settled in the middle of the field, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled outside in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. FOLDED went three to four wide on the first turn, settled in fourth position, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole, took a bit of an awkward stride when passing the gate tracks and just missed. ROYALTY RED CAT went four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, led into the stretch, was put to a drive, battled determinedly in the final furlong and also just missed. MOTORMECH saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and improved position. CONSERVATISM settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, moved out once straightened for the drive, advanced into reasonable striking position but lacked the needed kick. HANCOCK COUNTY was well placed just off the pace, advanced two then three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and weakened. DAILY MIRACLE was fractious in the gate, contested the pace, dropped back leaving the far turn and tired. DEACON DAVE broke out at the start, went five wide on the first turn and showed little.
