GREAT MILLS HIGH settled in the middle of the field while off the rail, moved up late on the backstretch, waited behind the leaders on the far turn, was taken up a bit off heels at the quarter-pole, found room when CITY LOVER vacated the inside, made a bid along the rail, battled gamely with the runner-up in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. CARELESS MOMENT went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four to five on the far turn, made a bid under a drive in upper stretch, battled gamely with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. SKIPAWAYWITHBING went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, bumped with a rival leaving the backstretch, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. E MOON was restless in the gate, raced off the rail on both turns, came under a drive in upper stretch and was no factor. THOUSAND EDENS had the rider break against her mouth, threw her head badly, spotted the field eight to ten lengths, lagged at the rear while on the inside, saved ground into the stretch, angled out outside the furlong marker then dropped back in again and improved position. MRS. GERTRUDE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, shifted five wide outside the quarter-pole, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. KAT'S CADY JO was restless in the gate, settled on the inside of a rival, was urged along late on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. CITY LOVER contested the pace on the inside of a rival while along the rail, came off the inside near the quarter-pole and stopped. JOHN LOUIS' MARKET disputed the pace on the outside, vied into the stretch and faded. FESTY'S FORTY WON broke in at the start, settled in third position, bumped with a rival leaving the backstretch, went four then three wide on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 15 Feet)
