TIDE RISING was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, accelerated to the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, edged clear under right hand urging, had the rider drop his right rein inside the furlong marker and held well under continued right hand urging. SINISTER brushed with a rival at the start then dropped back, raced near the back of the field, was urged along while off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive shortly thereafter and closed well but failed to overtake the winner. STRAIGHT SHOOTER settled off the pace, was urged some while off the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. PEACEFIELDS brushed with a rival at the start, showed good speed and contested the pace on the outside, failed to match strides with the winner in upper stretch and gave way. MIDNIGHT PASS contested the pace on the inside, vied into upper stretch and weakened. BONWELL was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. SILKY GIFT showed speed between rivals then dropped back, was urged along while inside on the turn and came up empty.
