**Footnotes**

ST. JOHN'S RIVER raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, surged to the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and drew away under strong urging then was hand ridden late. SHE'S PICKY raced four wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival while three wide on the far turn, was asked near the three-sixteenths pole and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. MAJESTIC TIGER raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, lingered towards the back of the field, was urged along while off the rail early on the final turn, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole and was best of the rest. OUR LADY IN RED raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the far turn and tired. PRATESI lugged out entering the first turn, raced six then five wide on that turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and improved position without threatening. SUMMER SCREAMER was in tight after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. FOREVER JENNY raced off the rail on the first turn, contested the pace, dropped out while inside on the far turn and capitulated. BROADWAY TUNE raced just off the pace while off the rail, was hard ridden on the far turn and came up empty. UPTOWN BROWN was rated on the inside, came up empty while continuing to save ground on the far turn and stopped. MY SHEPHERD GIRLS raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came up empty while four to five wide on the far turn and retreated.
