EXTRA QUICK went four wide on the initial turn, tracked the pace on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, kicked clear in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. FOREVER JENNY settled nicely off the pace, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, pursued the winner while under the whip into the final furlong and was second best. MISS MACABE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in shortly thereafter and was along for the show. VICTORIOUS BROAD was restless in the gate, went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace, came under some urging while three wide on the far turn, stuck a head in front passing the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch then gave way. RAINY SEASON was asked from the start, set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead while under urging near the five-sixteenths pole and tired. PURPLE BARBIE broke out at the start, was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn and came up empty. LASS WEST raced two to three wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, came under the whip while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten.
