OVERVIEW PRINCE'S close up between rivals, was out sprinted around the turn, loomed boldly a furlong out and failed to sustain her bid. PLAIN HONEY outrun early, saved ground around the turn, continued inside for the drive and lacked the needed late kick. TANGELO forward while four wide, continued out for the drive and hung. SILVER MINING close up from the rail, weakened. JANE CIA showed nothing in a dull effort.
