GRANNY'S PRIDE got clear early, responded when collared before the drive, shook clear and then proved best under strong handling. CROSSFIELD close up, loomed three wide nearing the drive and then failed to sustain his bid. POPOZINHA forwardly placed, bid along the rail around the turn and then had no final kick. DODD prominently placed, had no response. STARS ABLAZE was outrun. JUST A BABE between foes early, eased back entering the turn and then was no threat. OUI OUI CHEROKEE showed little. CARELESS OCEAN was always back. EMMA ANNE took a couple of bad steps in the early going and was pulled up.
