FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No Nomination Fee; \$300 to enter; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since November 22nd, allowed 2 lbs, \$30,000 since October 22nd, allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing.

NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High Weights will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, January 8, 2011, with 14 nominations.

EARLY RETURN came away in good order and took the early lead, set the pace while off the rail, vied off the rail on the turn, shook clear when asked in upper stretch, was given three strikes of a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip inside the sixteenth-pole and proved best under steady urging. MAMBO GALLIANO stalked the leader on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, chased the winner in the final furlong and was second best. LE GRAND CRU settled off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, was asked passing the five-sixteenths pole, moved out once straightened for the drive and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON settled at the rear of the compact field, lugged out a bit while near the inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response then just missed the show.
