FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$400 to enter; \$500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Preference to horses according to highest lifetime earnings excluding restricted races at the time of passing entry box. Equibase, Inc. records will be considered official for determining money earned. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. WILKINSON was reserved on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was urged some while inside on the far turn, came under strong urging at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed determinedly along the rail and got up late under strong handling. PANTS ON FIRE raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace while under a long hold, vied off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch, responded well when switched to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was denied. ACTION READY was taken in hand after the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging with three furlongs to run, held a good striking position into the stretch, was put to the whip in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and weakened while clearly best of the rest. MOBEETIE was a bit rank early then reserved at the back of the field, came under a ride while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. JUSTIN PHILLIP bobbled at the start and was last away, was a tad rank while four to five wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace on the outside while under restraint, was given his head while three to four wide on the far turn, came up empty at the top of the stretch and faded.
