DANCE CALLER set the pace under pressure, was asked to pick it up on the turn, inched clear passing the five-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage into the final furlong and held under measured urging. GRAND TRAVERSE pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back passing the five-sixteenths pole, was kept in by BE ME at the top of the stretch, eased his way off the inside near three-sixteenths pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed well late but missed. HEAVENLY CHORUS settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. BE ME tracked the leader on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail outside the quarter-pole, kept GRAND TRAVERSE in at the top of the stretch, was roused shortly thereafter and lacked the needed response. BERGMAN broke a bit slow, settled near the back of the field, raced towards the inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and failed to respond.
