**Footnotes**

GINORMUS broke a bit slow, raced four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, started to advance while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied under left hand urging in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker, was given one crack of a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and drew away under a hand ride late. CHOCTAW BILL brushed with a rival at the start, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, gained the lead near the furlong marker, was headed inside that marker and proved no match for the winner while able to secure the place. ISHEAJET lagged at the rear of the field, raced towards the inside, was in tight coming to the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and got up for the show. BURN RATE settled towards the rear of the field while saving ground, raced inside into the stretch and improved position. CASTNET KENT was a bit rank early then reserved off the pace, raced two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. LEESTOWNS FINALE raced five then four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and tired. ROYAL SPOKESMAN bumped with TECHE early on the initial turn, raced four then three wide on that turn, settled in the second flight, tracked the leader while three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid passing the three-sixteenths pole but came up empty. MACHO REGENT was caught seven wide early on the first turn then dropped to five wide, took the lead entering the backstretch, moved clear with five furlongs to run, led

while inside on the far turn, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. HOT ROD OVERTON raced up close to the pace while on the inside, chased while still inside on the far turn and came up empty. DIXIE DOT RUN brushed with a rival at the start, raced six then five wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. TECHE broke inward and bumped with a rival, bumped with ROYAL SPOKESMAN early on the first turn, raced three then two wide on that turn, was forwardly placed in the second flight, came up empty on the far turn and stopped. RADIANT MAN was bumped at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
