Footnotes

MY MAN DAN chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, rallied to the lead outside the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. DANGER STORM chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly while second best. THE HIDDEN ACE contested the pace on the inside of WILD PARTY, vied inside on the turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. WILD PARTY contested the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. INDIAN SUOVENIR was urged along on the inside, dropped back a bit while in tight off heels near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide shortly thereafter and failed to respond. HORNED FROG was last away, raced well behind while ridden along and showed little. SUNRISE STAR was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and also failed to respond.
