Footnotes

ONLY BOY lacked early speed while ridden along, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, saved ground into the stretch, rallied along the rail, was put to a left-handed whip passing the furlong marker, moved out while gaining fast and stormed past SMARTY GRAS late under hand urging. SMARTY GRAS set the pace through quick fractions, vied three then two wide on the turn, drew clear under a drive in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. GOVERNOR'S BADGE was void of speed while ridden along, went three then two wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and was along for the show. DYNAMITE LONNIE D stalked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure while four then three wide on the turn, lost touch with SMARTY GRAS in the final furlong and tired. DOLLAR SIGNS was urged along on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. KITTY BLONDE was urged along on the inside of DOLLAR SIGNS, chased while off the rail on the turn and weakened.
