JUST LIKE JIMMY angled to the rail entering the first turn, remained inside while advancing, moved behind the leaders nearing mid stretch, was steered in for room, slipped through to gain the edge and was clear. VALID PRIME devoid speed, rallied outside for the drive and got up for second. RUNAWAY CHOICE set a pressured pace, responded when headed, regained the lead and then had no final kick. CONSERVE raced inside until around the second turn, moved out for the drive, bid three wide and hung. ALMUHATHIR unhurried, rallied four wide but lacked the needed finish. FUNNY SOLDIER forced the pace outside RUNAWAY CHOICE, gained the edge before the drive and then gave way. JADADA close up off the rail, retreated around the second turn.
