HAZARDS OF LOVE raced four then three wide early on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail late on that turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, advanced three wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. CLASS CLOWN tracked the leader while four then three wide on the first turn, drew even with that rival midway down the backstretch, inched clear entering the far turn, controlled the tempo while off the rail on that turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. I TAKE DIAMONDS lingered towards the rear of the field, raced inside on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker, shifted further out in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and got up for the show. KARMA DISTRACTION was well placed near the inside, moved off the rail leaving the backstretch, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and came up empty. CRAFTY CAL bumped with a rival at the start then was taken in hand, raced two then three wide on the initial turn, stalked on the outside while under a hold, chased three then four wide on the far turn and tired. JOHNS LION was given a shake of the reins and showed good energy from the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace while under a snug hold, lost the lead near the half-mile pole, chased inside on the far turn and weakened. POPLARSAINT moved in at the back of the field, lagged at the rear while off the rail and failed to threaten. MAYOR TOM settled off the pace while off the inside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. NEON NAT raced four then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. SWEET SAINT MAK raced four wide on both turns and was no factor. ONE GOOD STORM bumped with a rival at the start, raced three then four wide on the first turn, settled on the inside of NEON NAT, dropped back after a half-mile and retreated.
