ANALYZER sprinted clear quickly, opened up in upper stretch and drew off late. INTERNAL FORCE close up from early on, dropped back a bit nearing the drive and came again for second. ST. HADIF trailed until before the drive, circled six wide while rallying and was up for third. STARS IN HIS EYES settled while out sprinted, loomed four wide a quarter out and failed to sustain his bid. CAJUN CLIFF steadied when in tight down the backstretch, saved ground thereafter and improved position. ST. REMY wearing a nasal strip, raced between rivals early and then improved position. UNION MILLS close up early, faded. DIESEL ELECTRIC between foes early, was outrun. WESTERN THUNDER prominent while three wide, offered his best a quarter out and stopped. OUT WE GO steadied when in tight down the backstretch, weakened. DAYTON'S BLUFF settled early, bid outside rivals and flattened out. HOLLYWOOD CAJUN fractious in the gate, showed little.
