GROVE PARK bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced five wide on the first turn, stalked the pace while under a tight hold, went four wide on the far turn, was asked a bit at the top of the stretch, bobbed near the three-sixteenths pole, was put to the whip while taking the lead near the furlong marker and powered away under good handling. KELLS BLUES raced four wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, went three to four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and gamely earned the place while no match for the winner. SOUTHERN LEGEND was rated while off the rail, came under some urging near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out and was asked for more in upper stretch, battled gamely for the place and just missed that position. QUIETDETERMINATION stalked the leader while three wide on the first turn, moved to the lead near the five-eighths pole, controlled the action while three wide on the far turn, was set down near the three-sixteenths pole, lost the lead in the vicinity of the furlong marker, failed to match strides with the winner, battled willingly for the minor awards and just missed those positions. JACK'S WORK set the early pace while off the rail, relinquished the lead near the five-eighths pole, tracked QUIETDETERMINATION into the far turn, was asked on that turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but weakened. SILVER COUNTRY raced three wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. U S C FIGHT SONG bumped lightly with GROVE PARK at the start, was taken in hand early, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved at the back, came under some urging while off the rail on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. WAKE UP SAL was taken back under a strong hold, raced inside on the first turn, was reserved at the back, came under some urging while inside on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
