A P DREAMER well back to the second turn, was angled out turning for home, finished big and proved clearly best. HAN SOLO crossed to the inside going to the first turn, settled until the second turn, advanced before the drive, eased out after turning for home, split foes late and got up for second. CIRCUMVENT reserved early, came four wide around the second turn and was along for the show. CAME LOW clear early, got out entering the first turn, was straightened quickly to set the pace, was collared a furlong out and then faltered. DUNSCOMBE stalked CAME LOW from early on, ranged up outside that one a furlong out and then failed to sustain his bid. HE'S A YANKEE saved ground too no avail. GOWDEN MILE within striking distance, faded. MONEY HAVEN showed little.
