GROOVINANDAMOVIN unhurried early, rallied mid track down the lane, responded to steady urging and was along in time. NAKIKA moved clear early, remained clear for the drive, then drifted out late and was no match for the winner. STORM EVON unhurried, split foes in the lane and got up for third. CLAUDIA BERTHA moved to the inside early, was restrained off the leaders, continued inside and had no response. ZIP ZIP ZEDE inside to the drive, eased out and could make little impact. COTTON IDE KATE charged the gate at the break getting off last, hustled up to contention down the backstretch, remained a threat to the drive, then flattened out. ROCKET REECE showed early foot, then faded. HEATNPAIN was always outrun.
