WHY NOT BE PERFECT settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, gained ground into the final furlong, lacked room along the rail late and missed the show. EVACUATION ROUTE was urged along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. WILDCAT NATION settled off the pace, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. COOL BULLET was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond.
