IRE tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch and edged clear under strong urging. GIVHANS FERRY showed good natural speed, set the pace while under restraint, was given some free rein on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead to the winner and was outfinished while clear for the place. CAT LORE chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. U BELONG TO ME was ridden along while off the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DIJARVO (GB) was in tight midway down the backstretch then moved out, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. ANNIE MARIA dropped well behind while ridden along and trailed.
