BIEN SUR settled early, steadied entering the turn, split foes midway around the turn, moved to the rail, eased out inside the furlong marker, collared READ ME MY RIGHTS and drew off. PURE INSTINCT forwardly placed, had no final kick. ACALADY devoid speed, advanced along the rail, moved out to split foes before the drive and rallied late. SELBORNE had no speed and rallied mildly mid track. TIGRESS WOODS saved ground. READ ME MY RIGHTS hustled clear early, faltered late. AIR FRANCE close up, steadied around the turn and then came again. MY CHANEL showed speed for a half and weakened. UNLACE was outrun. WALK THE LINE showed little. SHAKE'EM ON DOWN was always back.
