GHOST IS CLEAR was away alertly, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, took the lead passing the three-sixteenths pole, was given two quick cracks of a left-handed whip while clear into the final furlong and drew away under strong hand urging. RESCUE FINANCING showed speed on the inside, moved out behind SARACEN and chased that rival, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, battled past the three-sixteenths pole and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. SARACEN rushed up to take the lead and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, battled past the three-sixteenths pole and weakened while clear for the show. THE FREAK was urged along while off the pace, raced a bit off the inside on the turn and failed to rally. PITALE was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, steadied a bit outside the quarter-pole, steadied again while three wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. BACK ROOM DEAL was ridden along on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SPORTS DAY lacked early speed, dropped to the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. QUARRY OF GOLD was last away, raced near the back of the field while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.
