Footnotes

CREPE MYRTLE raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, moved to the lead while two to three wide on the far turn, edged clear when asked in upper stretch, extended the lead into the final furlong and just held under strong urging while drifting out a bit. PAOLI PRINCESS raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, was put to the whip at the top of the stretch, battled through a long drive, closed well late and just missed. INCLINED TO DREAM raced inside on the first turn, was reserved at the rear of the field, came under urging while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally while best of the rest. SHIMMERING PORT was well rated while a bit off the inside, lost the lead passing the three-eighths pole, dropped out in upper stretch and gave way. BETTY LOU dropped to the inside on the first turn, was well placed just behind the leader, dropped back a bit while inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty.
