WHEEMAWAY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure leaving the backstretch, vied three wide on the far turn, took over when asked in upper stretch and drew clear under strong urging. COLONIAL'S SCORE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace while off the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner, battled with that rival into the final furlong then proved no match while clear for the place. WILS REWARD went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along while five then four wide on the far turn and got up for the show. BURN RATE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to rally. METAIRIE was asked from the start, settled while off the rail, was ridden along on the far turn and failed to respond. CARRIGALLEN settled towards the rear, was urged along while four then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. AROUSAL raced five wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while five then four wide on the far turn and was no factor. UNDESIDED raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
