LADY WOODWIN bothered at the break, recovered, raced close up around the first turn, eased back down the backstretch, rallied three wide around the second turn, took over and proved best while kept to the task. MAG STAR devoid speed, rallied four wide around the second turn and while no match for the winner was best of the rest. HONOR THE RING three wide early, rallied from the rail and got up for third. MISS RUBY ANNA came in early, was straightened, prompted the pace three wide early, moved clear around the second turn and then weakened late. KATE DANAHER bothered at the break, recovered, saved ground until the drive, eased out and had no final kick. SOIREE LADY wide around both turns was outrun. TWO BUCKS LADY settled early, advanced five wide around the second turn and faded. NO REGRETA drifted out at the break, was straightened, vied for the lead and then stopped.
