Footnotes

IDEFROMTHEBAYOU was rated on the inside, bided his time through the final turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, made a bid along the rail, battled with ROSE MEDALLION in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. ROSE MEDALLION went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced four wide on the second turn, went three to four wide on the final turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, made a bid in upper stretch, battled gamely with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. WAJIR ON ME moved up the first time down the stretch, went three wide on the second turn, tracked the pace, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE went three then two wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, went two to three wide on the second turn, continued at the back, advanced four wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. AVOID stumbled badly at the start, raced four then three wide on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail entering the stretch for the first time, set the pace through very reasonable fractions, was asked with a quarter-mile to run, vied into the final furlong and gave way. LIME RICKEY was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the final turn, was guided out in upper stretch and failed to rally.
