Footnotes

LOOK AT THE TIME went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, edged clear near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in passing the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. ATTICUS THE MAN was in a bit tight against the rail nearing the first turn, saved ground on that turn, settled at the back, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. ONE SURVIVOR raced four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, vied outside on the far turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened then was caught for the place. SHAVE AND PAVE was a bit rank while three then two wide on the first turn, settled a bit on the backstretch, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and finished willingly but missed the minor awards. PARTY TIES was well placed on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. DAPPLE DOWN was reserved off the pace, waited briefly off heels outside the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. SOUTHERN BOO set the pace, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. EASING BY broke in the air but relatively with the field, went five then four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went four wide early on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and retreated. FORTY MORE WINS shifted four wide late on the first turn, moved up on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn and stopped.
