Footnotes

LEFT raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong handling. SPORTING HOLIDAY bumped soundly with WOLFCAMP at the start, was well placed just off the pace while a touch off the rail, drafted behind the leaders leaving the far turn, was roused shortly thereafter, moved out then rallied into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid passing the sixteenth-pole but missed. SANTO GATO was well rated while setting the pace, vied inside on the far turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to secure the show. TAPATIVITY was off slow, lingered near the back while on the inside, shifted three wide midway through the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SMARTER THAN EVER raced four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, was in tight near the furlong marker and weakened. BARRINGTON ROAD swerved six wide early on the first turn then dropped to five wide, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. ANNUAL UPDATE raced three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went three then two wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. INDIAN EDDIE raced inside on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was urged along between rivals on the far turn and failed to threaten. FRIENDLY BANTER raced three wide on the first turn, dropped near the back of the field and failed to respond. EBERLE was reserved in the middle of the field, raced inside on the far turn and also failed to respond. CONGO CAT

raced three then two wide on the first turn, was through after a half-mile and retreated. WOLFCAMP bumped soundly with SPORTING HOLIDAY at the start, raced two to three wide on the turns and was no factor. (Rail at 10 Feet)
