IDE BE A LADY sprinted clear early and remained clear throughout. CAPE TOWN LASS settled from the inside early, eased out in upper stretch, split foes and got up for second. PLEASANT EMILY close up, rallied turning for home and then had no final kick. SHEER LUCK devoid speed, angled out for the drive and closed mildly. NATIVE BRICK closest to the leader from early on, lacked a rally. LEOPARD HUNT wide early, moved up before the second turn and then failed to sustain her bid. DADDY'S PETUNIA raced inside to the drive, angled out and then closed late. QUICK ADVICE tired. CHILLING EFFECT dropped back. HOWL AT THE MOON dropped back. VANDALIZE restrained early, bid outside around the second turn and then stopped.
