MALIBU MONKEY clear early, set the pace thereafter and proved best while kept to the task. CHACAHOUA CHOICE forwardly placed inside, moved out nearing the drive, rallied and then just saved second. SANTONIO swerved in at the break, crossed to the inside before the first turn, moved up around the second turn, angled out for the drive and just missed second. GENUINE SPARK unhurried early, split foes around the second turn, then could make little impact. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT stalked MALIBU MONKEY to before the drive, then weakened. MASTER EWING MALOY raced wide. PLEASANT PACKY was outrun. ELEGANT LEGACY showed little. SEVENTYTIMESSEVEN was never dangerous. JERRY THE GENIUS between foes to the second turn, stopped. ERIC'S HABERNARO was no real threat. ZIG ZAG TOY tired.
