AVENUE B was sluggish in the early going while racing on the inside, moved up near the half-mile pole, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, rallied off the rail in upper stretch, closed fast under a few taps of a down-turned whip, gained the lead passing the furlong marker, quickly accelerated clear and proved best under a strong hand ride. QUIET TITLE bumped hard with FLAMING STRIKE at the start, was reserved off the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the far turn, remained unasked in upper stretch, was finally roused after DYNAMIC ROYAL drifted out inside the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the inside of that rival, steadied when that foe came in at the eighth-pole, chased the winner determinedly in the final furlong and finished with good courage for the place. DYNAMIC ROYAL was well placed just off the pace, made a bid on the outside passing the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, was steered back in near the eighth-pole, bothered QUIET TITLE in the process and weakened while clear for the show. MORENO STAR went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn, moved out once straightened for the drive and failed to rally. CLASSY SUAVE disputed the pace on the inside, inched clear midway down the backstretch, was challenged while inside on the far turn, dropped back in upper stretch and gave way. ROMANTIC CHANNEL broke in and bumped hard with FLAMING STRIKE then was asked, contested the pace on the outside, dropped back a bit midway down the backstretch, chased two to three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, had the rider lose his whip at that point, came five wide into the stretch and faded. FLAMING STRIKE was bumped hard on both sides at the start, raced off the pace while under some restraint, went wrong near the seven-sixteenths pole and was pulled up then vanned off.
