OPPOSITE DAY was taken in hand early then rated while in the two path, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths pole, advanced into upper stretch, was pulled off the heels of the leader at the three-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead before the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. TREATY OAK went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three then four wide on the far turn and finished with good courage for the place. ATTAINMENT broke about two lengths slow, was unhurried at the rear while on the inside, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole then four wide outside the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. FANCY TICKET was caught five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. RADIANT was carried four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, prompted the pace on the outside, drew even nearing the half-mile pole, inched clear leaving the backstretch, raced in the two path on the far turn, dropped close to the rail at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead before the furlong marker and gave way. WARRIOR ELITE saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, dropped in some in upper stretch and failed to rally. LOVING LORRAINE lugged out to be three wide into the first turn, dropped to the rail midway through that bend, set the pace, dropped out quickly into the far turn and tired. AND YOU CAN was well placed on the inside, dropped back significantly at the three-eighths pole, came off the rail at the five-sixteenths and had nothing left. (Rail at 30 Feet)
