Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since December 1, allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 since November 1, allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Happy Ticket Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights preferred. Footnotes

WARM BREEZE came away in good order, showed good speed on the inside, drifted off the rail while setting the pace, inched clear with a half-mile to run, controlled the action while along the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, went back to a right-handed whip while still clear at the sixteenth-pole and held desperately under strong urging. SAME CROSS settled well back in the field, went three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside under a left-handed whip, closed fast into the final sixteenth, was switched to a right-handed whip late and just missed. IRE was bumped on both sides at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the turn and secured the show. SWIFT ARTIST showed early speed, moved well out in the track while following the winner, chased four then three wide on the turn and tired. MALIBU HOLIDAY tracked the pace while being carried out, chased five then four wide on the turn and weakened. MAMA'S DIA bumped with IRE at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside while being carried out, chased six then five wide on the turn and came up empty. LOS OJITOS tugged at the bit while rated just off the pace, was carried out in the process, dropped in leaving the backstretch, drafted in the two path early on the turn, came under some urging at the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch and capitulated. POLAR PLUNGE bumped with IRE at the start, raced at the rear of the field, saved ground early on the turn, came off the rail around the five-sixteenths, swung four wide at the top of the stretch, moved out under a drive and failed to threaten.
