BROAD HARBOR forced the pace outside THE DALLAS DANCER until entering second turn, took over to move clear and the proved best under strong handling. FIDGET unhurried early, rallied between foes nearing the drive, loomed a threat in mid stretch and hung late. SPLIT THE ARROW saved ground and improved position. BEACHED settled along the rail, advanced before the drive, swung outside and could make little impact. CASH TYME reserved off the leaders, bid after BROAD HARBOR around the second turn and faded. CIELO GIRL forward for six furlongs, weakened. IKE AND FANNIE well back, was outrun. THE DALLAS DANCER dueled for a half and stopped abruptly.
