GO ANTE GO got clear early, was overtaken around the second turn, came again from the inside, angled out nearing the sixteenth marker, gained command and drew out. K BROWN four wide early, bid outside entering the second turn, eased to the inside while gaining the lead, gained the clear lead and then was no match late. MIDNIGHT DELIGHT unhurried early, rallied four wide nearing the second turn, offered her best around the turn and then faded. INTRACTABLE reserved early, bid outside around the second turn and then failed to continue on. GO MISS BAG within striking distance, had no rally. MARLEY'S DANCER trailed until the drive, swung out and was no real threat. BONNE IDEE raced inside and was outrun. VID FAREWELL crossed to the rail early, moved out around the second turn and then was no factor. QUEEN'S BOUQUET forwardly placed off the rail, steadied midway around the second turn and then dropped back.
