Footnotes

HEAR NO ANGEL unhurried while outrun, came inside around the second turn, angled out entering the drive while rallying, bid outside REW'S BLUES a furlong out and prevailed. REW'S BLUES never far back, came inside around the second turn, angled out in upper stretch, gained the edge but was unfinished. SMOOTHCIDUEUP angled to the inside going to the first turn, continued inside until the drive, eased out in upper stretch, was steered out late for room and made a late gain. DABBERS CHIEF crossed to the inside before the first turn, continued inside until the drive, eased out but lacked the needed finish. TELLING JOHN SCOTT vied for the lead to the drive, then weakened. SEA THE SOLDIER was outrun. ZACAROID vied for the lead to the second turn, then retreated. STAN MICHAEL L moved out early, raced wide and was eased. STORM ON A WING settled off the leaders, loomed three wide around the second turn, broke down entering the drive and was vanned off.
