Footnotes

COOL STREET saved ground on the first turn, dropped well behind while under urging, went two then three wide early on the far turn, shifted four while while gaining near the five-sixteenths pole, swept to the lead in upper stretch, battled with MAJESTIC HARBOR in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. MAJESTIC HARBOR lugged out while setting the pace, was guided around the far turn with heavy left-rein pressure, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought back on the inside of the winner and just missed. IT HAPPENED AGAIN saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. SABERCAT settled off the pace, drafted behind rivals late on the far turn, angled four wide at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. WORLDLY chose the four path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then tired. PASS THE DICE went four then three wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and came up empty. MR. BOWLING went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
