FIVE STAR FUN chased the pace on the outside then three to four wide on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and drew clear under steady handling. MEADOW GOLD MAKER moved up while urged along, raced four wide on the turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. REPUTA THE BEAUTAH moved in while off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, swung out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the show. GRACIE'S JOY chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and weakened. GOING AWAY BABY chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn and tired. WILD WHISPERS showed good speed and set the pace, came a bit off the inside on the turn, was asked for more near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. VICTORIA CROSS was ridden along while off the pace, raced four then five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. TRIBAL STRIKE was urged along on the outside, raced five wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the three-eighths pole and failed to respond.
