BOURBON COURAGE was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside, inched clear leaving the backstretch, controlled the action on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and drew off under strong urging in a nice debut. DRAGO'S BEST was away alertly, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and was second best. REVERE was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and was best of the rest. SCAT CHIEF chased the early pace, dropped back while towards the inside on the turn and weakened. CIGAR STREET bumped with a rival at the start then was taken up early and dropped to the rear, raced well back in the field, went four then five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. MACHO MACHO was ridden along near the back raced three wide early on the turn, waited briefly behind a rival near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide shortly thereafter and also failed to threaten. SOLD OUT SHOW was hard ridden while off the pace, raced a bit off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. CASTLEPOST disputed the pace on the outside, chased on the turn and tired. STREET SERENADE was ridden along in the back half of the field, went four wide on the turn, had the rider lose his whip outside the three-sixteenths pole and also failed to respond. QUANAH GOLD was bumped on both sides at the start, steadied near the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. WEST MONGOLIA was reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start then came in, moved out near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn and never reached contention.
