MACABE'S GOLD moved to the lead and set the pace, controlled the tempo while off the rail on the turn, extended the advantage without much encouragement in upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong, was given a few reminders with the whip near the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under good handling. ANTE GO GO settled on the outside, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked near the three-eighths pole, moved out in upper stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. A BIT STORMY was last away, threw his head while hard held and rank, raced two wide early on the turn, shifted three wide and was finally given his head near the three-eighths pole, continued three wide into the stretch, moved out once straightened for the drive and was best of the rest. MIDNIGHT PASS tracked the leader on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip and weakened. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. DUCLAW settled on the outside, was ridden along while three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
