Footnotes

LONGMORN trailed early, made a run four wide around the turn, came five wide through the lane and was up in time. NICE TRICK devoid of early foot, advanced around the turn, angled in in mid stretch, gained the lead late and just failed to last. CARSON CAN CAN five wide early, loomed boldly a quarter out and could not deep up late. MINER'S KEY out sprinted early, ranged up between rivals and then flattened out. HANNAH BEAR prominent four wide, took over before the drive and faded late. WHOA BABY WHOA vied between rivals early, then gave way after a half. LADY CATHERINE close up early, dropped back in the drive. I'M A TUDOR flashed speed and stopped.
