Footnotes

CRY CRY CRY reserved behind the leaders early, was eased out nearing the drive, ranged up outside BEAR'S MARIE in mid stretch and prevailed. BEAR'S MARIE stalked STORMIN RILEY from early on, bid outside that one around the turn, gained the edge, then while no match for the top one, was best of the rest. HYPER HANNAH unhurried early, moved to the inside before the turn, continued inside until the drive, eased out and passed tiring foes. STORMIN RILEY set the pace to before the drive, got headed and then weakened. CHARMER RIDGE off last, moved up before the turn, was under stout restraint around the turn, eased out and could make little impact. WILD BUSHROSE well back to the drive, improved position. STORMY JILL veered out at the break, then was not a factor. SWEET CRY forwardly placed off the rail, faded. RANUNCULA wide early, dropped back.
