COTILE LAKE pressed then chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leader while three wide on the turn, battled with that rival in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. VERY POSSEBULL set the pace under some pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, battled with COTILE LAKE in the stretch and was outfinished late while clear for the place. ALL STAR COLTON was well placed on the inside, shied from a shadow midway down the backstretch, chased inside early on the turn, moved off the rail inside the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. AMERICAN EFFECT was urged along while off the pace, brushed with rivals while between those foes near the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. OPEN ME UP was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and failed to rally. WHAMS NITE OUT was last away, raced on the outside while ridden along, was caught five wide early on the turn, dropped to three wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. MR. BUZ was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, brushed with AMERICAN EFFECT near the five-sixteenths pole and faded. NEVER SAY GOODBYE dropped back while traveling a bit awkwardly, fell far behind the field, raced two to three wide on the turn and showed little. RON JOVI was ridden along near the back, raced off the rail on the turn and faltered.
