Footnotes

NECAISE raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, vied inside on the far turn, battled with WHY NOT BE PERFECT in the stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. WHY NOT BE PERFECT raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, battled with NECAISE in the stretch and missed. TWILIGHT BAY settled off the pace, moved closer with five furlongs to run, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick late and settled for the show. BUY WITH GOLD raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, came under urging on the far turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, quickly gained ground, loomed a threat while under strong urging in upper stretch but flattened out. EURO CASH was rated while towards the inside on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the backstretch, came up empty while urged along and saving ground on the far turn then dropped out.
